### Notes from the July 6 meeting of the Harrison County Board of Supervisors

The following actions were taken on July 6:

- \* Richard Marsh was reappointed to represent District 4 on convention and visitors board.
- \* An order was approved to install streetlights at the intersection of Menge Avenue and Woodland Way in District 3.
- \* Approved authorizing the City of Biloxi to use voting equipment for the city's Aug. 4 special election.
- \* Approved waiving rental fees for the D'Iberville Civic Center for the City of D'Iberville to host a special election Aug. 3-4.
- \* Approved receipt of a grant award from Retired Senior Volunteer Program for operation of RSVP in the amount of \$69,031 for FY 2020-2021.
