The Harrison County Board of Supervisors approved a contract with Southern Mississippi Planning and Development District (SMPDD) to administer the 2020 CARES Act. SMPDD will provide all administrative and closeout services necessary to carry out all grant-related activities for the county's CARES Act program. MEMA was allocated \$70,000,000 of CARES Act money to assist counties and municipalities with their COVID-19 expenses.


President Rockco also presented a technical scholarship to Qualique Lyles. Qualique is the son of Quinton Lyles, who represents District 1 on the Harrison County


